Rudolfinum (C4): Neo-Renaissance building, home to Czech Philharmonic Orchestra and Art Gallery.

Municipal House (D4): The Czech National Symphony Orchestra is in this Art Nouveau building.

Mucha museum (D4): An Art Nouveau dream!

Kafka museum (B4): Transcend the fallacy of realism with Kafka.

National Gallery: Engage in cultural richness and embrace the Czech national spirit.

Veletřní Palace—Modern & Contemporary Art (D2): 200 years of painting, furniture, and design.

Šternberg Palace (A4): European art from Classical Era to Baroque.

Day Trips

Kutná Hora & Ossuary: Famous medieval silver-mining town with "bone church" and St. Barbara Gothic Cathedral.

Karlštejn: Fairytale castle about 45-minutes southwest of Prague.

Terezín/Litoměřice: Nazi prison camp and Jewish ghetto in a massive 18th century fortress.

Pilsner Urquell Brewery: Experience pure Pilsner from Plzeň in the largest brewery in the Czech Republic, about 1.5 hours outside of Prague.

Green spaces

Petřín Hill (A4/5): Prague's "Eiffel Tower" offers picturesque views.

Stromovka Park (C/D1): Once the hunting grounds of Rudolf II, great for picnicking, biking and relaxing.

Vyšehrad Castle (C7): This is where Prague started! Wander in joy and melancholy.

Letná (C/D3): Home of the Giant Metronome, beer garden and a hillside overlooking the Vltava.

Riegrovy Sady (E5): Local favourite in warm weather for picnics or drinks in the popular beer garden.


Wallenstein Gardens (B4): Meander through this tranquil, baroque-style garden, get to know some peacocks, and take a look at the unique "drip wall" at the other end of the garden.

Public Transport

Metro hours: 5am–midnight; Tram hours: 4:30am–midnight; Night Trams (S1-S9): midnight–4.30am; Tram and Metro Stop for Miss Sophie's: I.P. Pavlova.

The Metro is easy to figure out since there are only three lines: A, B, and C. Validate your ticket in the small yellow boxes before going to the Metro platform. For trams or buses look for the red and yellow tram or bus signs. You'll need a ticket before you board since you can't buy them on trams or buses.

At the tram stop white or yellow numbers are day trams and the blue are night trams. Below the numbers you'll see a list of tram stops and a schedule. Your stop is the one underlined. The trams that stop next to a metro are marked with a metro symbol: Easy! On the schedule "Pracovní den" means "Monday to Friday", "Sobota" is "Saturday", and "Neděle" is "Sunday."




Bar Nota, Štěpánská 9
Small music & cocktail bar, with regular events such as live jazz or latin music and Oldies nights.

Alex Bistrot, Ječná 4
Small restaurant-café with original French, Italian and Czech dishes & breakfast the whole day! 10% discount on breakfast menus & pasta with this map!

Pivovarský dům, Ječná/Lipová 15
Microbrewery & restaurant with special beers, e.g. cherry beer, and typical Czech dishes. Reservation suggested.

Banditos, Melounová 2
Try the great Mexican food, traditional classics (Burgers etc) or breakfast till 6pm! Many specials during happy hour (Mon.-Fri. 4:30–6:30pm) and free Wifi.

Beas, Bělehradská 90
Vegetarian dhaba restaurant with typical North Indian cuisine. Closes at 9pm (Sunday 6pm).

Hlučná Samota, Záhřebská 14
Inspired by Hrabal's stories, a famous Czech writer, this place is one of the great bar-restaurants in this area. Typical Czech food & sitting outside in summer!

Zvonařka, Šafaříkova 1
Restaurant with a big summer terrace and nice view of Prague. Offers both Czech & international dishes.

Lahůdky Zlatý Kříž, Ječná 39
Basic café including a shop selling baguettes, cakes or the like, which opens early at 7am (Mon.–Fri., closes at 6pm). Ideal spot for early risers!

Bio Zahrada, Belgická 33
Try their tasty sandwiches, soups, cakes, coffee, wine and more in this cosy café that feels like home. Includes an organic food shop. 10% discount with map!

Meduza, Belgická 17
Nice café in the Vinohrady neighborhood, with lots of tasty home-made snacks & desserts.

Zlutá Pumpa, Belgická 11
Friendly Café-Bar with Mexican food, snacks, lots of cocktails and all kinds of other drinks.

Hidden Treasures

Prague Zoo (C1): One of the best in the world!

Botanical Gardens (C1 & C6): Try out the one in Troja, just next to the zoo. Huge greenhouses with butterflies, nature paths and outdoor exhibits.

Lennon Wall (B4): A constantly changing graffiti wall and symbol of resistance against the now fallen communist government.

Vitkov Hill (F4): Home of the largest equestrian statue in the world; focus on the breathtaking view!

Olšanské Hřbitovy: This old Jewish/Christian cemetery houses the real grave of Franz Kafka.

Vyšehrad (C7): Enjoy the views and hang with the locals over a Gambrinus or Pilsner and grilled goodies.

Sandemans New Prague Free Tour

In our opinion this is the best walking tour in Prague! It is based on tips only, so if you like it, you can tip the guides at the end, but you never have to. Tours start daily at 11am and 2pm at the edge of Old Town Square/ Pařížská (C4), both in English and Spanish, and last 3 hours with a break in between. If you want to get to know the city, then we recommend this tour with its cool guides!

Clock Tower Bar Crawl

A pub crawl, and a fun one. Free unlimited beer, wine, vodka, rum and absinth shots till 11pm, then welcome shots, VIP club entrance and entertaining guides! So if you venture to join a pub crawl with all its possible consequences, then we recommend this one. Meeting point daily at 9:15pm at the Astronomical Clock at Old Town Square (C4)—look for the CLOCKTOWER logo. Tickets at reception. Enjoy!

Patagonia Outlet

If you like Patagonia and you're looking for some new outdoor clothing, then we have good news for you: in Prague there is a Patagonia Outlet, with prices up to 70% off! We support their approach to environmental engagement, such as donating 1% of their sales to environmental organisations. A good thing to do. Open daily 10am–8pm. Revoluční 1 (D4).

Segway Experience Tours & Rents

Segway? That's a two-wheeled, self-balancing vehicle—and lots of fun! You can experience it on a 3-hours Segway-city tour, starting daily at 11am & 3pm at Mostecká 4 near Charles Bridge (B4), or on a Movie tour at 7pm. Information and discounted tickets (1350 Kč instead of 1500 Kč) at reception!

Beyond Prague

Olomouc is a beautiful university town full of parks, fountains, and cathedrals. We recommend checking out the sweet digs at Poet's Corner.

Český Krumlov is the perfect fairytale bohemian town in the foothills of the Šumava. The town is small but rich in character. Walk crooked cobblestone streets and breathe in the atmosphere of woodsmoke, the Vltava rushing by, and the clear air your city-filled lungs crave.

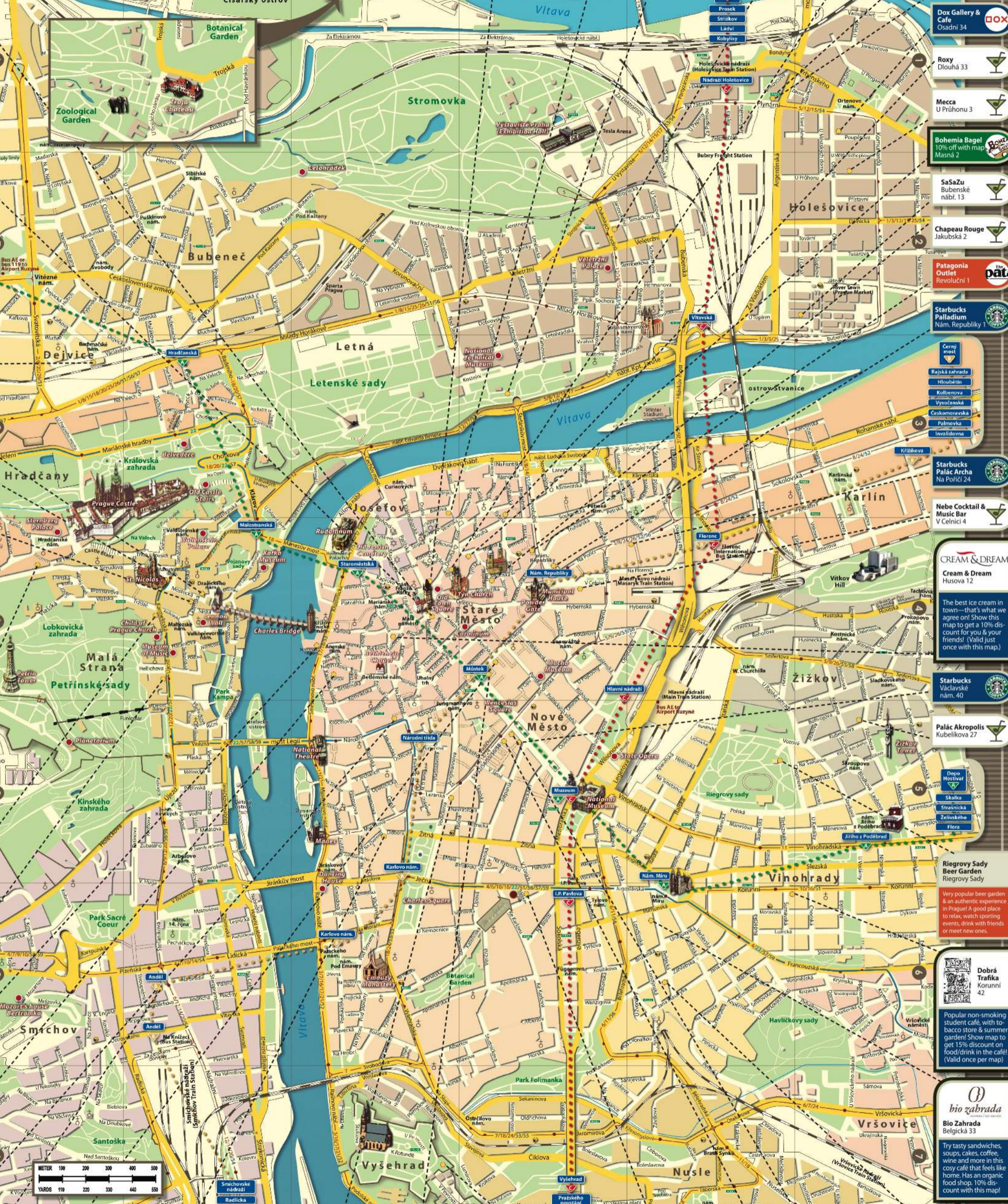
